

A MIXTURE OF GRANITE, ICE AND KAYAK

Day 1: Our departure will be at 7:30 in the morning to the Torres Del Paine (Laguna Amarga Entrance). Private transfer to Las Torres Camp, here we will set the campsite and trekking to "Las Torres" viewpoint (7 hrs.). The trip goes on Ascencio Valley, Lenga and Coigue forest on the side and a great granite rocks valley to get to the "Las Torres" viewpoint. In this strip there is a gradient of 800 Mts. approximately. Dinner and Breakfast at the camp prepared by the guides/assistants.

Day 2: In the morning a transfer picks us up to the "Laguna Amarga" Sector, here we connect with the regular bus to Pudeto Refuge to cross the Pehoe Lake in a Catamaran Boat. A trekking by the Grey Lake shore will take us to Grey Glacier (4 hrs.) of spectacular sights of Olguin Mountain Range, Bariloche Peak, Ferrier, and Donoso among others. Dinner and Breakfast at the camp prepared by the guides/assistants.

Day 3: Ice hiking over the great Grey Glacier in the morning; here expert guides will lead us on cracks and strange glacial formations during 4 hours. In the afternoon we will navigate over the Grey Lake to the Grey Hostel (1,5 hrs.). Private bus to the "Río Serrano" Camping **(A mini bus will pick up the kayak and equipment in Puerto Natales and then wait for the costumers at the Admistration of Paine)** - Night at the Camping Sites-Lamb Barbecue at the night - Breakfast prepared by the Guide.

Day 4: Early in the morning we move to the shore of Serrano River. Then we will have a short introduction about Kayaking, security and equipment. Now we start the soft descent along the River until our Camp: "PEKIN GUERRERO" Ranch, after rowing (5 hrs.) approximately. The Serrano River is inside of the biggest Chilean National Park; with more of 2 millions hectares the Bernardo O'Higgins National Park shelters a great quantity of lakes, glaciers and untouched forests. The kayaking is the cleanest way of visiting this gorgeous place. - Tent night, dinner and breakfast prepared by the guide.

DAY 5: We leave the "Pekín Guerrero" Ranch; we row the last (3 hrs.) to the mouth of Serrano River, place where it meets Ultima Esperanza Fjord. This route is filled of colors, and little by little we will see the impressive peaks of the Balmaceda Mount (2000 Mts). Our kayak trip ends in Puerto Toro and here we connect the boat that takes us to Puerto Natales after visiting the spectacular Serrano Glacier, after that only (3 hrs.) of navigation through to the "Última Esperanza" Fjord to lead us in Puerto Natales city in the evening -
